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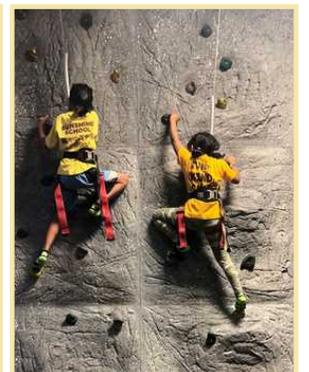
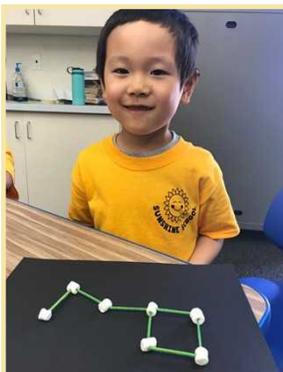

SPECIALTY CAMPS

Specialty camps are offered during our Summer Program and will be a three-hour long session each day, either during the AM or PM time slots (see schedule). These classes are not part of our regular Summer Program session, and are only specific to the class.

DAILY ACTIVITIES

ACADEMIC ENRICHMENT

Each day, students participate in structured academic sessions designed to prepare them for the upcoming school year with confidence and success. Our program focuses on next-level learning to help students strengthen foundational skills, build new knowledge, and stay ahead academically. All academic materials are included in the tuition.

At Sunshine Summer Program, we combine learning, engagement, and fun—creating a space where students grow academically while enjoying their summer.

AWESOME ACTIVITIES & OUTDOOR PLAY

Children will participate in a wide variety of creative crafts and engaging activities designed around our Summer Program Weekly Themes (see schedule). Each week introduces a new theme that encourages exploration, imagination, and hands-on learning. Activities may include art projects, group challenges, STEM-based experiments, storytelling, cultural exploration, and collaborative games that reinforce creativity, teamwork, and critical thinking skills.

Specialty camps such as Clay Art, Soccer, and Fitness (Dance and Yoga) will be available on select weeks. Free Chinese language class is also available!

Outdoor playtime is great for healthy development. It enables children to enjoy unstructured play and have a fun release of energy!

FREE BREAKFAST, LUNCH, AND SNACK

To better serve our families, the program provides free breakfast, lunch, and afternoon snacks each day. We are committed to offering balanced, child-friendly meals that help students stay energized, focused, and ready to learn and play.

For lunch, children may bring a meal from home or enjoy a hot lunch provided by Sunshine School. Please note that Sunshine School does not offer a specialized menu for children with dietary restrictions. If your child has food allergies or specific dietary needs, we strongly recommend that families pack their own snacks and lunch to ensure their safety. Please refer to the lunch menu for more details.

FIELD TRIPS/ON-CAMPUS EVENTS

Our field trips and on-site events provide children with enriching, alternative educational opportunities. Field trips and on-site events are included in tuition for Full-Time students.

Part-Time students who wish to participate in off-campus field trips must notify the office at least one week in advance. A \$40 transportation and admission fee will be added to tuition. Part-Time students who wish to participate in on-campus events must also notify the office one week in advance, and we will do our best to accommodate their participation.

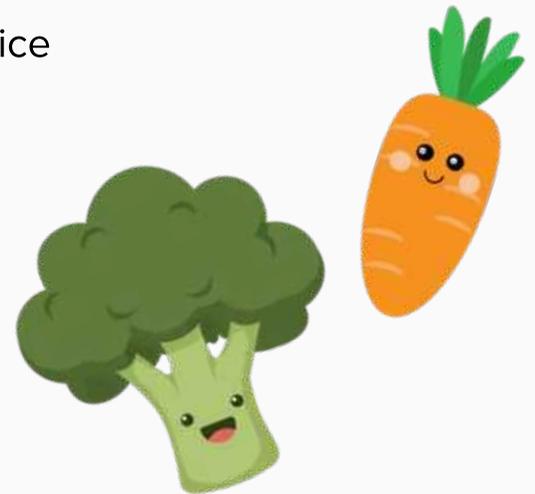

REGISTRATION & PAYMENT

HOW DO I REGISTER?

To register for the Sunshine Summer Camp, parents will need to submit the following:

Registration is required at least one week prior to attendance. Drop-ins and same week registrations will not be accepted. All paperwork must be submitted online prior to start date.

WHAT IF I WANT TO ADD ADDITIONAL WEEKS TO MY REGISTRATION?

Please submit a new registration form for the add-on weeks.

WHAT IF WE NEED TO CHANGE THE WEEK WE REGISTERED TO A DIFFERENT WEEK?

Parents may request to transfer the amount of tuition paid to a different week at no additional cost ONLY if they inform the Office one week prior to the registered week. Transfers will not be accepted without a one week notice.

ARE THERE ANY REFUNDS/CREDITS IF MY CHILD'S SCHEDULE CHANGES AND NO LONGER NEEDS TO ATTEND THE PROGRAM?

Families may request a refund for any unattended week(s) only if they inform the Office at least one week prior to the registered week(s). A \$30 administration fee will be applied for refunds. Refunds will not be issued without a one week prior notice. All eligible refunds will be issued in the form of a check and mailed out at the last week of the summer program.

WHAT IF MY CHILD IS ABSENT FOR A SPECIALTY CAMP SESSION?

Unfortunately, we cannot offer refunds, transfer of tuition, or make up classes for missed classes due to any type of absence. Regular attendance is encouraged for all students enrolled in our Specialty Camps.

ARE THERE ANY DISCOUNTS IF WE REGISTER ALL 8 WEEKS OF SUMMER PROGRAM?

Yes, there is a \$100 discount if all 8 weeks of the summer program are paid in full. This offer is available for Full-Time students only, and can be combined with the sibling and early bird discount.

IS THERE A SIBLING DISCOUNT FOR THE SUMMER PROGRAM?

Sunshine offers a 10% discount for each additional sibling. All students must be enrolled in the full-time program to receive the discount. Please contact the Sunshine office to apply the discount to your account before registering any additional siblings.

WHAT IS THE EARLY BIRD SPECIAL?

DOES SUNSHINE ACCEPT GOVERNMENT AID FUNDING/SUBSIDIES PROGRAMS?

Sunshine has been proud to support and participate in government aid funding and subsidies programs. For details regarding eligibility and the specific paperwork required, please check directly with our office, as documentation requirements may vary by program.

IS THERE A LATE PICK-UP FEE?

Sunshine School Summer Camp operating hours are 8:30am - 6pm. If a child is picked up later than the scheduled pick-up time, parents shall be assessed a fine of \$1.00 per minute for each minute late. Please note that our Specialty Camp hours are different from our regular Summer Camp hours. Students who are enrolled in Specialty Camps only (without the addition of an AM or PM session) must be dropped off and picked up on time or an early drop-off/late pick-up fee will be charged.

WHAT ACADEMIC ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES ARE OFFERED?

Each day, students will practice next level education (in preparation for the upcoming school year). Subjects may vary from math to language arts subjects such as reading, grammar, and phonics. All academic materials will be included in the tuition.

ARE THERE ANY EXTRACURRICULAR CLASSES AVAILABLE?

Free Chinese class will be provided for students who register for the class. Specialty camps such as Clay Art, Soccer, and Fitness (Dance and Yoga) will be available on select weeks for an additional cost.

ARE MEALS PROVIDED BY SUNSHINE?

Breakfast, lunch, snacks, and fruits are offered daily. Children are welcome to bring their own meals and snacks from home, or enjoy a hot lunch provided by Sunshine. Breakfast and afternoon snacks are optional for students. Please note that students are required to bring a disposable bagged lunch for all field trips and on-campus events.

DOES SUNSHINE OFFER ANY ACCOMMODATIONS FOR DIETARY RESTRICTIONS?

Sunshine School does not offer a specialized menu for children with dietary restrictions. If your child has food allergies or specific dietary needs, we strongly recommend that families pack their own snacks and lunch to ensure their safety. Please refer to the lunch menu for more details.

- A **change of clothes** (applicable to TK, Kindergarten, and 1st grade students)
- A **bagged lunch** on field trips / school event days (preferably disposable)
- **Wear a Sunshine T-shirt** on field trip / school event days (shirts may be purchased at the Sunshine office)

WHAT ARE SPECIALTY CAMPS?

Specialty camps are offered during our Summer Program and will be a three-hour long session each day, either during the AM or PM time slots (see schedule). These classes are not part of our regular Summer Program session, and are only specific to the class.

Families may sign up for Specialty Camps sessions only, and are not required to attend the program for the full day. Families who would like to attend the Summer Program for the full-day, may choose to add the AM or PM option in addition to their Specialty Camp session.

Clay Art Camp: Students will create beautiful 3-D art using air dry clay. This camp can help expand your child's motivation for thinking and creativity, develop their sensory and motor skills, and provides a calming effect through hands-on creations!

Fitness Camp: Partnering up with StepOn3, this camp offers a perfect blend of movement, music, and mind-building activities. Along with energetic dance classes in Hip Hop and K-Pop, kids will enjoy exciting add-ons like fitness sessions and Yoga, keeping them active and energized. To balance physical activity with mental growth, we've included engaging STEAM sessions for our little STEAMers and chess, helping children build focus, creativity, and problem-solving skills.

Soccer Camp: Students of all skill level will train and participate in various activities, including dribbling, passing, shooting, and teamwork. This camp will help build stamina, agility, and expand on social skills, self confidence and leadership through healthy competition.
