





DAILY ACTIVITIES

ACADEMIC ENRICHMENT

Sunshine Summer Program provides a safe, interactive, and enriching space for children from prekindergarten to 12th grade. Each day, students will practice next level education (in preparation for the school year in Fall 2023). A workbook is required for all students attending the Summer Program for three weeks or more.

AWESOME ACTIVITIES

Children will participate in various crafts and activities that are available based on the Summer Program Weekly Themes (see schedule). Extracurricular classes such as Soccer, Kung Fu, Zumba, Chess, Competitive Math, Spanish, and Clay Art will begin in the second week of our Summer Program (registration will be available in June).

FREE BREAKFAST, LUNCH, AND SNACK

Breakfast is served from 9:30 to 10:00 AM. Afternoon snack is served around 3:00 to 3:30 PM, depending on your child's grade. Breakfast and snacks consists of waffles, cereal, fruit, crackers, and other delicious and nutritious munchies. For lunch, children can either bring their own lunch from home or enjoy a hot lunch provided by Sunshine School. Sunshine School does not provide a special menu to children with special diets. If your child is not able to eat certain foods or is allergic, it is a safer option for those children to bring their own snack and lunches to school.

OUTDOOR PLAY

Outdoor playtime is great for healthy development. It enables children to enjoy unstructured play and have a fun release of energy! Our field trips and on-site events will provide alternative educational opportunities for children.

WHAT TO BRING

- A facemask (a spare one can be brought if needed)
- Bring sunblock (labeled with your child's name) daily
- 2 sets of cups and bowls + utensils for snack and lunch each day
- A water bottle (labeled with your child's name) every day
- Bring a bagged lunch and wear your Sunshine T-shirt on field trip / school event days

PARTICIPATING TERMS

HOW TO PAY FOR SUMMER TUITION

In order to reserve a space for your child in the summer program, tuition is required to be paid in full at the time of registration OR a deposit of one week's tuition (\$415 for full-time or \$270 for part-time) is required. Families may pay by the set schedule payment schedule below. Families are required to pay by the Deadline for any and all weeks that are in a Payment Session. Deposit is applied to the first week your child will attend the Summer Program. **Registration is required at least one week prior to attendance. Drop-ins and same week registrations will not be accepted.**

SIBLING DISCOUNT

There is a 10% discount for the second child while both children are enrolled in the FULL-TIME program.

FIELD TRIPS

Field trips and on-site events are included in Tuition for Full Time Students. Part Time Students who wish to participate in any Off-Campus Field Trips must inform the Office a week in advance and a \$40 Transportation and Admission fee will be applied to tuition. Part Time Students who wish to participate in any On-Campus Events must inform the Office a week in advance and we will do our best to accommodate free of charge.

LATE FEE

A 10% late fee will be applied to unpaid tuition after the payment session deadline.

CANCELLATION/TRANSFER/ REFUND POLICY



Transfer the amount of tuition for the week missed to a different week. Parents may use the full amount for the week missed to sign-up for additional week ONLY if they inform the Office one week in advance. If there is not a notice of one week in advance, transfers will not be accepted. There will be a fee of \$100 charged for each week of summer camp that is missed. Refunds will be mailed the last week of summer program.



A Refund can be returned in the form of a check. Parents may be refunded the full amount for each week of summer that is missed ONLY if they inform the Office one week in advance. If there is not a notice of one week in advance, there will be a fee of \$100 charged for each week of summer camp that is missed. Refunds will be mailed the last week of summer program.

LATE PICK UP FEE POLICY

If a child is picked up later than the scheduled pick-up time, parents shall be assessed a fine of \$1.00 per minute for each minute late.

SUNSHINE SCHOOL FIELD TRIP PERMISSION SLIP AGREEMENT AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

In exchange for participation in the field trips organized by Sunshine School, which involves transporting the children using private vehicles and/or the use of the property, facilities, and services of Sunshine School. I agree to the following:

- 1. I agree to observe and obey all of the posted rules, warnings, and further agree to follow any oral instructions or directions given by Sunshine School or the employees, representatives, and agents of Sunshine School.
- 2. I recognize that there are certain inherent risks associated with the above described activity and I assume full responsibility for personal injury to myself, and (if applicable) my family members. I further release and discharge Sunshine School for injury, loss, or damage arising out of my or my family's use of or presence upon the facilities of Sunshine School, whether caused by the fault of myself, my family, Sunshine School, or other third parties.
- 3. I agree to indemnify and defend Sunshine School against all claims, causes of action, damages, judgments, costs or expenses, including attorney fees and other litigation costs, which may in any way arise from my or my family's use of or presence upon the facilities of Sunshine School.
- 4. I agree to pay for all the damages to the facilities of Sunshine School caused by my child/ren's negligence, recklessness, or willful actions.
- 5. I consent to the participation of my child, a Sunshine School Student, in field trips organized by Sunshine School which involves transporting the children using private vehicles. I also agree on the behalf of the minor (named below) to all of the terms and conditions in this agreement. By signing this release of liability, I represent that I have legal authority over and custody of my child.
- 6. Any legal or equitable claim that may arise from participation in the above shall be resolved under California law.

HOW DO I REGISTER?





COVID-19 SAFETY

EVERYDAY PREVENTION

- All students attending our Summer Program are required to wear a facemask while at Sunshine.
 Exceptions are only for individuals with a medical condition, mental health condition, or disability that prevents wearing a face covering.
- Enforce proper hygiene measures: washing hands thoroughly with soap and water, use of hand sanitizers, covering coughs and sneezes with elbow, etc.
- Cleaning and disinfecting high-touch surfaces throughout the day
- Screening:
 - Temperature will be taken at sign-in with a no-touch thermometer for all students and staff, and is monitored throughout the day
 - Individuals who have a fever of 100.40F (38.00C) or above or other signs of illness should not be allowed
 into the facility. This includes fever, cough, difficulty breathing or other signs of illness within the last 24
 hours. Staff and children who have been exposed to individuals with the symptoms listed are also not
 permitted to enter the facility.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

- Students will be assigned to stable groups/cohorts that are as small as practicable.
- Parents are not allowed inside our facilities at this time to minimize the number of adults in close contact with our students and personnel.
- Drop-off/Pick-up Procedures:
 - Staff will sign students in and out daily, please make sure to sign the authorization form in this packet.
